Marianna's Lazy Daisy Days: Babbity Baby Hat

Material:

4 mm Needles. I use a 16" circular needle and just knit straight (not in the round).

"3" Weight Wool in Main and Contrast color

Newborn Baby - $11^{"}$ circumference, $5\frac{1}{2}$ " high Using contrast colour yarn, cast on 56sts 1st Row: S1, knit to end of row Repeat this row 5 times more Using main colour yarn ~ 7th Row: S1, knit to end of row Repeat this row once more Using contrast colour yarn ~ 9th Row: S1, knit to end of row Repeat this row 7 times more Using main colour yarn ~ 17th Row: S1, knit to end of row Repeat this row once more Using contrast colour yarn ~ 19th Row: S1, knit to end of row

Repeat this row 7 times more

Cut off contrast colour yarn and continue using main colour only ~		
27 th Row:	S1, knit to end of row	
28 th Row:	S1, purl to last st, k1	
Repeat the last 2 rows 6 times more		
Shape Top ~		
Next Row:	*K3, k2tog, repeat from * to last st, k1	(45sts)
Next Row:	S1, purl to last st, k1	
Next Row:	*K2, k2tog, repeat from * to last st, k1	(34sts)
Next Row:	S1, purl to last st, k1	
Next Row:	*K1, k2tog, repeat from * to last st, k1	(23sts)
Next Row:	S1, purl to last st, k1	
Next Row:	K2tog across row to last st, k1	(12s†s)

Cut the yarn leaving a 'tail'.

With a yarn needle, pull the yarn through all the remaining loops and secure Sew up side seam and weave in ends

You can create a pom-pom to put on top or just leave as-is.

Optional ending:

Continue one more row of K2tog (6 sts)

Then do an I-cord for 18-20 rows which creates a tail at the top. Tie a knot in the I-cord (see YouTube for instructions on doing an I-cord)
